BACKGROUND

The El Dorado County Transit Authority (El Dorado Transit) staff typically reports monthly and fiscal year-to-date ridership at each Board meeting.

DISCUSSION

For the month of March 2024, ridership across all three (3) modes of service continued to trend up. Fiscal Year-to-date ridership was up 21.9% overall.

The attached March 2024 Ridership Report compares systemwide monthly passenger trips to the same period in the previous fiscal year. Overall ridership increased by 15.9% compared to the previous year. Demand Response ridership increased by 35.1%, Local Fixed Route ridership increased by 15.3%, and Commuter ridership increased 2.4%.

The attached Fiscal Year-to-Date Ridership Report compares the current fiscal year to the same period in the previous four (4) fiscal years to analyze pre-Covid and current ridership trends.

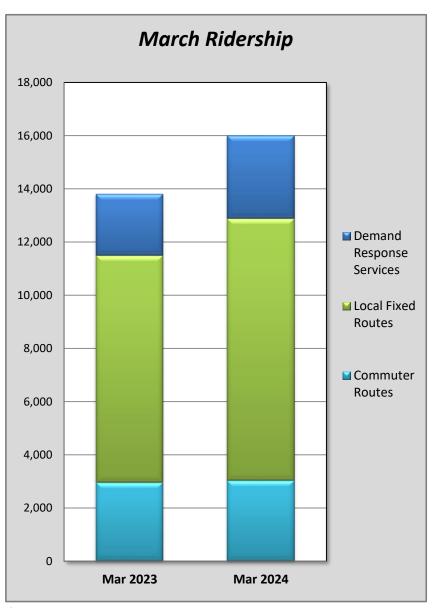

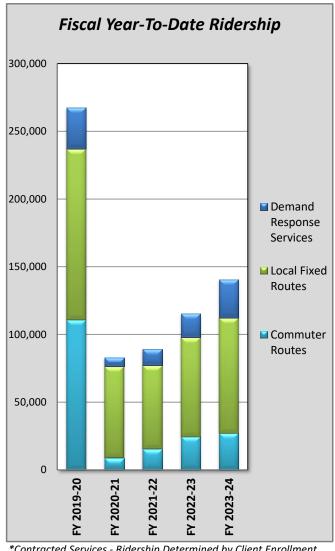

- 3. Approve Blanket Purchase Order No. B30013 issued to Hunt & Sons, Inc. in the amount of \$80,000 for fiscal year 2024/25

BACKGROUND

The El Dorado County Transit Authority (El Dorado Transit) purchasing procedures allow an exemption to competitive bidding per the following section of the approved <u>El Dorado Transit Procurement Policies and Procedures Manual</u>:

"Chapter 3; Section 14 Sole Sources Procurements:

- b) Sole source procurement may be used only when the award of a contract is infeasible under small purchase procedures, sealed bids, or competitive proposals and at least one of the following circumstances applies:
 - 5. The unique nature of the property or service required precludes competitive bidding."

El Dorado Transit Purchasing Procedures and the Joint Exercise of Powers Agreement establishing El Dorado Transit require Board approval for Purchase Orders over \$25,000 and Purchase Requisitions over \$5,000.

El Dorado Transit operates a fleet of sixty-one (61) vehicles and the fleet consumes an average of 2,177 gallons of unleaded gasoline and 11,884 gallons of green low sulfur diesel fuel per month under normal, pre-pandemic operating conditions.

DISCUSSION

El Dorado Transit purchases green low sulfur diesel and unleaded gasoline from two (2) local commercial cardlock fuel vendors daily due to the proximity of the facilities and the availability of differing types of fuel. Transit Operators and maintenance personnel fuel vehicles during the hours of 5:00 AM to 8:00 PM Monday through Friday and from 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM each weekend. Additional fueling is necessary during special shuttle services such as the Fair Shuttle.

Fuel prices at commercial/retail fuel vendors typically fluctuate daily based on the market. As a result, vendors are precluded from providing El Dorado Transit a set contract price for fuel at the pump the way they might if they were delivering fuel to a facility on a regular basis. This daily price fluctuation does not lend itself to formal competitive bidding procedures; therefore, the El Dorado Transit Board has allowed an exemption from competitive bidding on fuel since 2000.

Due to the operational need for daily fuel purchasing at commercial card lock vendors and the nature of daily fuel price fluctuations, it is recommended that fuel procurement be identified as exempt from competitive bidding. With approval, purchase orders will be issued to the two (2) local cardlock vendors that have provided price quotes using a set amount per gallon above their cost. The Executive Director certifies that these purchases are included within the preliminary approved operating budget for Fiscal Year 2024/25.

FISCAL IMPACT

Purchase Order B30007 – Dawson Oil Company 5040.01 Fuel Purchase \$670,000

Purchase Order B30013 – Hunt & Sons Inc. 5040.01 Fuel Purchase \$80,000

Purchase Order amounts are above budget line-item amounts as presented on the Preliminary Operating Budget FY 2024/25 adopted on April 4, 2024; the total budget for fuel is \$750,000. The blanket purchase order amounts allow for flexibility between vendors however, the budget will not be exceeded prior to Board action if needed.

WHEREAS, El Dorado Transit has received structured price quotes from all vendors; and

WHEREAS, approved El Dorado Transit Procurement Policies and Procedures Manual: Chapter 3; Section 14(b)(5) allows for exemption from competitive bidding by resolution when the unique nature of the property does not lend itself to bidding; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED; that:

- 1. The purchase of fuel is considered unique in nature due to the daily fluctuation in price and is hereby declared exempt from competitive bidding.
- 2. The Executive Director is authorized to purchase fuel from outside vendors.

Approve the Donation of one (1) Surplus Vehicle to Local Non-Profit

Organization

BACKGROUND

The El Dorado County Transit Authority (El Dorado Transit) replaces transit vehicles on a regular basis according to an adopted Vehicle Replacement Policy. Those vehicles designated as surplus are typically sold at a public venue, parted out, or donated to local non-profit organizations or governmental agencies.

El Dorado Transit fleet vehicles used in the delivery of public transportation are sought-after by various non-profit agencies because they are well-maintained and wheelchair accessible. The approved Board Policy G-4 allows for the donation of vehicles designated as surplus to local non-profit organizations that provide services to El Dorado County residents. The policy further authorizes the Executive Director to develop and implement a competitive process for potential applicants to apply for the transfer of a surplus vehicle.

DISCUSSION

El Dorado Transit published a public notice and contacted local non-profits directly soliciting applications for the donation of one (1) wheelchair-accessible minivan. The application period ran from March 25, 2024 to April 12, 2024 and a public notice was published in the Mountain Democrat.

El Dorado Transit received one (1) application. Staff is recommending the Board award the donation of Vehicle #1304 to Mother Lode Rehabilitation.

FISCAL IMPACT

The vehicles were depreciated to zero value, insurance coverage will be terminated, and title and ownership will be transferred to the recipient.

Authorize the El Dorado County Transit Authority and the Executive Director to execute contracts for Payment Acceptance Device Hardware and Transit Processor Services with Kuba, Inc. and Littlepay, Inc., through State of California leveraged procurement agreements

BACKGROUND

In February 2022, El Dorado Transit applied for Transit and Intercity Rail Capital Program (TIRCP) funds in a partnership with Sacramento Regional Transit, Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG), the Capitol Corridor Joint Powers Authority (CCJPA), and other local transit providers. The region was successful in its application and was awarded nearly \$2.2 million to purchase, install, and implement Cal-ITP supported contactless payment equipment and services on bus fleets throughout the region. The full funding amount was allocated to the region at the California Transportation Commission meeting held in December 2023. The allocation requires El Dorado Transit and its partner agencies to enter into contracts for payment acceptance device hardware, and for transit processor services (fare calculation) by June 7, 2024.

A subrecipient agreement with SACOG directing the flow of funds for El Dorado Transit has been drafted and is in the final stages of review. El Dorado Transit's share of the \$2.2 million is approximately \$600,000 and is expected to provide sufficient funding to purchase and install the necessary equipment from Kuba Inc. to outfit El Dorado Transit's entire vehicle fleet. El Dorado Transit will incur ongoing service charges for the transit processor services to be provided by Littlepay, Inc. that will be paid for through the Operating Budget.

DISCUSSION

Transit demand and ridership patterns have changed significantly in recent years. In an effort to increase ridership and make it easier for community members to ride transit, expanding contactless payments should be implemented.

El Dorado County Transit Authority May 2, 2024 This project will continue the expansion of El Dorado Transit's fare payment options for customers, allowing them to purchase fare at the time of boarding the bus using contactless payment technologies. The convenience of paying a fare with an existing contactless enabled credit card, Google Wallet, Apple Pay, or other digital payment, will simplify the fare payment process, speed up boardings, and therefore improve El Dorado Transit's on-time performance.

Staff is requesting that the Board authorize El Dorado Transit and the Executive Director to execute contracts for Payment Acceptance Device Hardware and Transit Processor Services as presented.

FISCAL IMPACT

The hardware purchasing and system implementation fees associated with this project will be paid for with TIRCP funds that were awarded in 2022, and will be provided to El Dorado Transit through a subrecipient agreement with SACOG.

There will be no fiscal impact to the FY 2023/24 Operating Budget as El Dorado Transit will not incur any operating costs in FY 2023/24. Operating costs beginning in FY 2024/25 have been included in the preliminary FY 2024/25 Operating Budget through Connect Card. The costs for the Littlepay, Inc. services will be based on actual transaction volume at a rate of 2.25% per transaction for fare sales and \$.02 per transaction for free fares if implemented.

BACKGROUND

Safe driving awards are presented annually to El Dorado County Transit Authority (El Dorado Transit) Operators who meet a minimum work hour criterion for the program and who were not involved in on-the-job moving violations or chargeable accidents.

El Dorado Transit Operators are trained and licensed to operate all the agency's fleet vehicles including wheelchair accessible mini-vans, medium duty cutaways, low floor transit buses with air brakes, and over-the-road commuter coaches with air brakes. Transit Operators are consistently challenged with varying driving conditions ranging from mountainous roads to congested freeways and downtown streets of the Sacramento urban corridor.

In the calendar year 2023, El Dorado Transit Operators provided a total of 163,334 passenger trips, traveled 937,660 miles in revenue service, and clocked 45,966 in-service driving hours.

DISCUSSION

This year's awardees consistently demonstrated their commitment to providing safe and reliable transportation through all manner of operational challenges and proved their exceptional driving skills by avoiding any moving violations or chargeable accidents.
